BLACK HISTORY MONTH

In 1906 J. W. Armstrong, J. T. Burton, F. S. Belcher, E. E. Desverney, Robert W. Gadsen, G. W. Jacobs, H. A. McBeth, C. A. R. McDowell, Henry Pearson, L. S. Reed, Julian Smith and A. L. Tucker founded the Colored Library Association of Savannah to address the lack of library service available to Black citizens of this area.

It's first library was at Price and Huntingdon Street. In 1913 the association petitioned the Carnegie Corporation for funds to build a library. Funding was provided and on August 14, 1914 the dedication was held for the Carnegie Library. Prior to intergration, the Carnegie Library at 537 East Henry St. served as the library for blacks in Savannah.
