Introductory Rites: Entrance, Greeting, Penitential Act, Gloria, Collect (Opening Prayer).

Liturgy of the Word

First Reading, Responsorial Psalm, Second Reading, Gospel Acclamation, Gospel, Homily, Profession of Faith and General Intercessions.

Living the Eucharist

Living the Eucharist is a dynamic, parish-based designed to help revitalize parish life and mission through a profound experience of Sunday Mass. It helps the entire parish-adults, teens and families grow in their Catholic faith and live more fully as missionary disciples of Jesus. Living the Eucharist runs during Lent for three years.
